#### E-learning course for students

An interactive online course aimed at improving students' key competences, with a particular focus on the use of ICT and its application to everyday life contexts.

#### Toolkit for teachers

A practical and modular tool that offers methodological guidelines, teaching activities, and digital resources easily adaptable to classroom needs.

#### Role-playing activity 'Adults on Stand-by'

An educational activity based on role-playing scenarios, allowing students to develop decision-making and problem-solving skills in an immersive environment. The game encourages active learning and can be integrated into the curriculum to enhance engagement and transversal competences.
