The I-TEEN project (Empowering Inclusion of Disadvantaged Teenagers through ICT) aimed to promote inclusion and the development of the European key competences among secondary school students, with special attention to those facing social, economic or psychological disadvantage. Through the use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT), I-TEEN has provided innovative tools and inclusive methodologies to support both teachers and students.

Main Results

- Teacher Toolkit: methodological guidelines, teaching activities and practical tools for inclusive education.
- Online Course for Students: an interactive path to develop key competences through ICT.

- Role-playing Game “Adults on Stand-by”: promotes problem-solving, collaboration and cultural integration.
- Multilingual e-learning Platform: resources available in English, Italian, Spanish and Slovenian.
